OUR DOCTORS RECOMMEND A COMPREHENSIVE EXAM WITH RETINAL IMAGING/ DILATION ANNUALLY.

Retinal imaging/dilation allows us to better manage your ocular health and possibly detect conditions you may not have been aware of. Potential conditions include:

Diabetes
High Blood
Pressure
Stroke
Cancers/Tumors
Macular
Degeneration
Floaters
Retinal Tears
Detachments

A comprehensive exam with retinal imaging may not be covered by insurance and would therefore be an additional fee. Imaging requires **NO** eye drops, does not affect pupils, avoids all dilation side effects and can be done in seconds. It also provides a more consistent, visual form of health documentation when done annually.

A comprehensive exam which includes <u>dilation drops</u> is typically covered by most vision plans. Dilation drops will temporarily enlarge your pupils and has the potential to cause side effects including things such as:

- Blurry vision at near, including cell phone and computer distance
- Sensitivity to lights for at least 4 hours
- Headache and/ or eye strain for the day
- I prefer to have my exam with RETINAL IMAGING ONLY (\$25 fee if not covered by insurance.)
- I prefer to have my exam with RETINAL IMAGING & DILATION (\$45 fee if not covered by insurance.)
- I prefer to have my exam only with DILATION ONLY (\$20 fee if not covered by insurance.)
- I prefer an UNDILATED exam.
